



Student Support Team (SST)

Do any students in your courses, or in any other regular contact (such as in advising or in a work-study position in your office), appear to be experiencing significant difficulty?

If so, please consider referring them to the Student Support Team (SST).

The SST is a group of professional staff and faculty who craft intervention strategies in support of students facing any of a wide variety of personal, social, and/or academic challenges. The goal of the SST is to identify students at risk as early as possible in order to offer proactive support. All referrals are kept confidential.

Information is shared within the Student Support Team on a need-to-know basis and is in compliance with the professional confidentiality standards of each of those involved.

Mission:

The Student Support Team, composed of Unity College professionals representing a network of services, identifies and helps students who could be at risk. The team collaborates to help connect students at potential academic, social and personal risk with appropriate campus and community resources. The group attends to trends on the Unity College campus and applies higher education research regarding at risk behaviors and trends to Unity College and acts as a campus advisory group regarding the same.

The Student Support Team is a MELMAC grant supported initiative.
