



CENTERS OF ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Each of Unity College's five Academic Centers will be awarding one \$32,000* scholarship starting in the Fall 2010. Applicants for this competitive scholarship must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale and a minimum SAT score combination of 1650 or ACT composite of 24.

**this \$32,000 will be awarded in increments of \$8,000 per year. Application for this scholarship is also open to transfer students with a college gpa of 3.25 or higher. However, the total amount of the scholarship will vary for transfer students depending number of semesters completed at Unity College.*

Eligibility for First Year Students

- Applicant must meet all normal admissions requirements of Unity College as specified in the current catalog.
- Applicant must enroll in a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, or Bachelor of General Studies program with the intent to graduate from Unity College.
- Applicant, after enrolling, must maintain a satisfactory academic and social standing as defined in the college catalog and the student handbook.
- Applicant must have minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.50 on 4.0 scale.
- SAT combined score of 1650 or a composite ACT of 24 with no individual score less than 21.
- Exceptions are considered for highly qualified applicants.

Eligibility for Transfer Students

- Applicant must meet all normal admissions requirements of Unity College as specified in the current catalog.
- Applicant must enroll in a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, or Bachelor of General Studies program with the intent to graduate from Unity College.
- Applicant, after enrolling, must maintain a satisfactory academic and social standing as defined in the college catalog and the student handbook.
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative college GPA of 3.25 and earned a minimum of 15 college credits. Transfer students with less than 15 credits must also submit high school transcript.

Application Requirements

FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN

- Scholarship Application
- Teacher recommendation
- Official high school transcript (we can use copy sent to Admissions)
- SAT or ACT scores
- Resume
- Essay

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Scholarship application
- Professor Recommendation
- Official College transcript(s) (we can use copy sent to Admissions)
- Resume
- Essay
- Official high school transcript (only if transferring less than 15 college credits)
- SAT or ACT scores (only if transferring less than 15 college credits)

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Scholarship Application
- Teacher recommendation
- Official HS or College transcript (we will use copy sent to Admissions)
- SAT or TOEFL scores
- Resume
- Essay

The scholarship application and supporting documents must be submitted to the Scholarship Review Committee no later than February 1st. Any applications postmarked later than February 1st will not be considered.

A formal scholarship cannot be awarded until the student has applied for admission and been accepted as a student to attend Unity College.

Scholarship Award Information

- This is an annual scholarship and is awarded only to a first-time freshman or to a transfer student who has not previously attended Unity College. The student must be full-time with at least 12 credit hours per semester.
- The scholarship is renewable for up to three years provided the student maintains a cumulative GPA of 3.0. If the student fails to maintain this GPA at the end of each year, or fails to meet all other criteria, he/she is not eligible for scholarship renewal towards the next academic year
- This scholarship is for \$8,000 per year (\$4000 per semester), and will be reflected on the student's account each semester as long as he/she qualifies.
- If the student takes less than 12 credit hours, drops out of a degree program, withdraws from school, or fails to maintain all the criteria, the remainder of the scholarship may be forfeited.
- This scholarship replaces all other Unity College academic based scholarships.
