

# Northern Forest Canoe Trail Summer Internship Program



The core internship season will run from June 11 to August 16. Interns will be compensated \$2,500 plus mileage reimbursement when using a personal vehicle for work.

## *Roving Stewardship Interns*

Will be part of a five person crew taking part in a variety of stewardship projects in every state the NFCT passes through. Work will include trail and campsite construction and maintenance, erosion control, and stream bank stabilization. Each intern will be responsible for leading a Waterway Work Trip composed of up to 6 volunteers. Interns will receive training and have the opportunity to interact with a variety of professionals in the recreation, habitat/wildlife, and land management fields.

## *Youth Program Interns*

The Northern Forest Explorers Outdoor Program engages rural youth aged 10-14 living in communities along the NFCT route in five day outdoor educational experiences that support active and healthy lifestyles, cultivate leadership and teamwork skills, and foster a practical understanding of the natural environment.
