Responsibilities: Lead and teach trail construction and other projects ♦ Provide leadership and training to corps members and volunteers ♦ Submit reports ♦ Coordinate food, equipment, and transportation for a team of 6 people ♦ Camp in tents along with team members during service sessions.

Qualifications: One season of trail work experience with one season in an outdoor leadership role ♦ Ability to teach trail skills ♦ Previous experience with construction work ♦ Must be in good health and physically fit ♦ Position requires a sense of humor and the ability to maintain a safe and enjoyable service environment ♦ Must be at least 20 years old ♦ Must be a US Citizen ♦ Must be able to motivate and work with people of all ages and backgrounds ♦ **Women and Minorities are encouraged to apply**
