Adventure Staff would lead activities such as, but not limited to: Wilderness Survival Skills, Rock Climbing, Environmental Ethics, Team Building, Camp Skills, Hiking, Map & Compass & GPS as well as lead overnight trips on and off campus.

Job Requirements

Applicants will be provided with training, but must have at least one year experience working with youth in the outdoors, as well as some trip leading experience and have completed at least one year of college. Applicants must have a minimum of Wilderness First Aid or similar certification, including a current CPR certification. Must be able to hike long distances with a backpack and be able to teach the classes listed above.

Must be able to work between June 18th and August, 17th as well as attend trainings when available.
