The New Hampshire Marine Patrol is **NOW** hiring for the position of Marine Patrol Officer Trainee for the **2012** summer season. Marine Patrol is the primary state agency responsible for ensuring safe boating on the State's waterways. **Testing Dates (TBD) will be hosted in October, November and December.** All testing will be administered at New Hampshire Police Standards and Training in Concord.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: Completion of high school, G.E.D. or equivalent.

Experience: No experience required, however, experience in operating boats or previous law enforcement experience is desirable.

License/Certification: Within six months, applicant must successfully complete requirements to be certified as a part-time police officer by the New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council unless already certified and certification is still in effect. *Must possess a valid driver's license and be able to obtain through Marine Patrol training a valid New Hampshire Boating Education Certification.*

Special Requirements:

1. Must be a least eighteen (18) years of age at time of Conditional Offer of Employment.
2. Must be in good physical condition; applicants selected for employment must submit a physician's statement of health prior to employment.
3. Must be able to pass a 50 yard free style swim test.
4. Must be willing to accept employment in assigned geographic location.
5. Must pass written aptitude and physical fitness tests, psychological examination, oral board, background investigation and subject to polygraph examination administered by the Division of State Police.
6. Must successfully complete specified in-house Marine Patrol training.
