Foster a spirit of cooperation, safety, teamwork, responsible stewardship, and fun. Work in remote locations doing hard physical labor. Transport AMC program participants and/or equipment. Maintain an accurate record of volunteers participating, work completed, and expenses. Maintain tools and equipment. Co-instruct LNT Trainer Courses, as needed. Purchase and package food and equipment for program. Assist with program registrations and database management. Other office duties as needed. Qualifications: Experience in youth leadership, preferably in outdoor settings, highly desired. Experience in backpacking, required. Strong computer skills, experience with Excel and Word, preferred. Valid drivers license with a clean driving record. Knowledge of basic trail work skills, desirable. Background in environmental sciences or education, desirable. Ability to work independently and multitask. Desire to do hard work in the outdoors. Physical ability to travel safely in the backcountry in all weather conditions, carrying up to 50 pounds of gear. Must hold valid driver's license and be able to pass DOT medical exam. Must have safe driving record and practices, subject to verification through a driver's license history check.
